

International Seminar „Shaping the 72 hours campaign together!“ Aachen and Münster, 14.03. – 17.03.2019



The 72 hours social campaign is organized by the Bund der Deutschen Katholischen Jugend (umbrella organization of Catholic youth associations) and its members. From May 23 to 26, 2019 young people all over Germany have three days to realize their project, which can be interreligious, political, environmental etc. The campaign's homepage is www.72stunden.de. In preparation, we want to meet for an international seminar in Münster from March 15 to 17, 2019. We want to take the opportunity to network, to develop ideas together for international projects within the 72 hours campaign and to discuss their implementation and funding possibilities.

Who can participate?

- Networking between Catholic German youth organizations and partner organizations in other European countries
- Exchange of experience in the field of international cooperation
- Developing project ideas for the 72 hours campaign together
- Working on these ideas and making plans for their implementation
- Getting in touch with possible partner organizations
- Receiving information about funding possibilities for international projects

Participants from abroad are exclusively invited to the opening event of the Saint Joseph's Day. It takes place in Aachen on March 15. This year's motto “Building bridges!” focuses the perspectives of young people in Europe. Therefore, the arrival to Germany is already on March 14, 2019.

What does it cost?

For participants from abroad the seminar is free of charge. Accommodation, food and program costs will be covered.

Travel costs from abroad will be reimbursed after the submission of the original travel documents. Reimbursement is conditional to the grant of funding and goes up to a maximum amount of 250 euros. Please travel to a price as low as possible.
